

## ROS GEAL UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE ACADEMIC YEAR 2012-2013

### **Application**

Applicants should return the completed application form together with two written character references, (an academic reference and a reference from an employer/coach. Neither should be family members). Once the application form is received, applicants are invited to visit the Residence, see the facilities and an interview is arranged at a mutually convenient time with the management. Preference is given to students pursuing a full third level course or postgraduate studies.

### **Regulations**

Students are requested to observe the regulations of the Residence which includes a curfew most nights. To enhance academic achievement and social interaction it is management policy to limit television viewing. Where observance of the regulations proves unsatisfactory, a student's continued stay in the Residence cannot be guaranteed which latter decision is at the discretion of the management. The management cannot take any responsibility for items lost, damaged or stolen on the premises. Management reserve the right to levy a charge for any damage caused during a student's stay in the Residence.

### **Accommodation**

The Residence provides both single and shared serviced accommodation. Fees to the Residence cover four meals daily; breakfast, lunch or packed lunch, dinner and a light supper. Bed-linen and towels are provided. Excellent study facilities are available in the Residence. The use of a pc suite and broadband internet access are included in the fees. All other expenses such as heating, electricity, hot water are also included in the fees paid. Optional personal laundry service is available at the cost of €240 per semester which is additional to the fees listed below.

### **Fees**

Students are expected to stay for the full academic year. Any additional weeks the student stays in the residence must be paid for in advance. *Fees are paid in two installments; before 29<sup>th</sup> August 2012 and January 3rd 2013 payable directly into Ros Geal's bank account, details listed below. Please note that once the fees are paid they are non-refundable.* They are divided according to shared (€165 per wk) or single (€180 per wk) accommodation. A non refundable booking fee of €200 is payable immediately in order to secure a place when accepted. Students who wish to return in September can pay €200 advance deposit and their luggage can be stored.
